I am writing to oppose the sections of House Bill 2002 - Reproductive Health Services (partially) and Gender-Affirmation Treatment (in full).

Reproductive Health Services

Providing abortion should not be a responsibility of an Educational Organization. Students who need this and other medical services can get them from their medical provider.

Also, any additional services provided by a college will naturally be included into tuition. This is illogical and unethical to ask everyone to pay extra to already ridiculously high tuition to cover services that have nothing to do with the education, especially since these services can be provided in many specialized medical facilities elsewhere.

Please remove this requirement from the Bill.

Gender-Affirmation Treatment

In the last 10 years or so there was a 10x explosion in a number of children and teenagers who identify as transgenders. This cannot be explained by the claim that in the past transgenders were afraid to speak up and now they are not, otherwise we would have seen a similar rise in adult transgenders population, but this did not happen.

In the past several decades the LGBT-spectrum people enjoyed at least the same rights and freedoms as heterosexuals, and in many cases they had even more of those - they have their own flag, own month, own Parade and other events.
