Dear Representatives,

Adults aged 18-20 are old enough to vote, enter into contracts, join the military without parent permission, and get married. It is unreasonable for something like HB 2006 to deny them Second Amendment rights. There is no indication that this group of adults contributes to crime, this bill just strips them of their rights.

This bill, and similar ones before this Committee, only seek only to disarm us law-abiding citizens and continue eroding our Second Amendment rights without improving public safety.
