  - -\$268 M total impacts



#### **IMPLAN Results 2002-2021**

Using the independent client NIST survey results, the Northwest Economic Research Center (NERC) calculates the full multiplier impact through an IMPLAN study each year. Results from 2002-2021 (there is a one year lag in IMPLAN analysis to capture full year of data:
