Please support HB 3464.

The effects of this error are far-reaching; by helping efforts to re-establish beavers in our landscapes, this bill will work to support crucial wetlands conservation and combat the effects of climate crisis, particularly drought and wildfire.

It is incorrect to classify beavers as predators. Beavers are not animals that prey on other animals.
