I am a landlord in Eugene. About 19 months ago I received a bid to roof a duplex. The bid at that time was \$10,000.00. Last week I contacted the roofer and asked for an updated bid. His written bid came in at \$15,000.00. The wages I pay my two employees have gone up approximately 5% a year the last three years. The cost of electricians and plumbers have easily exceeded 15% per year the last two years. Perhaps a better way forward would be to expand the urban growth boundaries. At some point it will make more sense to sell the units, although this will remove some of them from the rental pool.
