The Philippine American Chamber of Commerce of Oregon (PACCO) is a 27-year-old nonprofit organization serving Asian American, Pacific Islanders, Black, Latine, including various socially and economically disadvantaged entrepreneurial Oregonians. I am the President/Interim Executive Director of PACCO and serve as an appointed council member of the Governor's Racial Justice Council and co-chair the GRJC Economic Opportunity Committee. During the last three years, PACCO has been deeply engaged as a community-based organization delivering culturally responsive business education programs and limited funding assistance through ARPA dollars.

I write to you today in support of the 2023-2025 Business Oregon's biennium budget SB 5524. Business Oregon and its hard-working staff are vitally important to an inclusive business environment and equitable economy. The comprehensive development and innovative planning led by Business Oregon sets the platform for a future Oregon that fosters a healthy, resilient, and prosperous Oregon.

Through the Technical Assistance Program, over thirty culturally responsive organizations like PACCO, with targeted areas of focus and industry, have designed and grown effective programming that communities, urban and rural, have come to trust and rely upon by thousands of Oregon entrepreneurs. We fully support funding the COBID Capacity, the Rural Opportunity Initiative, Technical Assistance Program, Economic Equity Investment, Industrial Site Readiness, as well as items from the Governor's Recommended Budget package such as Broadband, Early Childcare Assistance, Advanced Manufacturing Opportunity Fund.
