We are a small and dedicated operation, and ONAC supported us by providing key technical assistance training, primarily helping us to develop our first PNW Tribal Agriculture Guide and assisting in tax filing. I am an enrolled member and shareholder of the Chugach Alaska Native Corporation and the Valdez Native Tribe, and receiving this kind of support from a Native American organization was vital.

As a small business owner, I am voicing my strong support for ONAC and the Technical Assistance program. Sakari Farms and other Native-led operations are stronger because of what ONAC does, and I am requesting Business Oregon to continue its funding of this key program. Thank you very much.
