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Dear Chair Neron, Vice-Chairs Hudson and Wright, and members of the House Committee on Education:

I strongly support of House Bill 2767, which will create a long-term, sustainable funding and governance model for recovery high schools in Oregon. Recovery high schools provide a safe, supportive education for youth in recovery from substance use and mental health disorders. It is critical that Oregon begin investing in these life-saving programs.

HB 2767 was designed by experts from the Oregon Legislature, the Oregon Health Authority, the Oregon Department of Education, the Alcohol Drug and Policy Commission, COSA, and ESDs. It offers a clear, collaborative path forward to expand, support and govern recovery high schools across the state.

Gladstone, like communities across Oregon, has seen a rise in teen mental health issues and the substance abuse that can result from depression and anxiety. While we are doing what we can to provide weekly on-site therapy through partner agencies, we know a number of students need more extensive supports to recover and succeed in graduating.

Oregon ranks last in the nation for substance use treatment and recovery support. This legislation provides a cost-effective and proven way to support adolescents in recovery as they work to gain their high school diploma.
