I am also looking into programs to assist with home internet service, and home repairs. I am a mother of 4, with my 2 youngest still living in my home. (They are ages 17 and 23) i am grateful for the opportunity to share a little of my testimony/story. There are so many of us who wouldn't be able to survive without assistance. So non-judgemental help/assistance is gravely appreciated. I have worked since I was 16, as I was a very young mother. This is only the 2nd time in my life unemployed.
