I am a criminal defense attorney. Many of my clients suffer from substance abuse disorders that arose in adolescence. This bill is important to me because I feel that many of my clients could have avoided a criminal lifestyle had they received an appropriate level of treatment at a younger age.

Oregon ranks 47th in the nation for substance use treatment and recovery support. This legislation provides a cost-effective and proven way to support adolescents in recovery as they work to gain their high school diploma.
