In support of US Second Amendment right given to US citizens I oppose HB2005

The Second Amendment to the United States Constitution protects the right to keep and bear arms for self-defence in the home. It was ratified on December 15, 1791, along with nine other articles of the Bill of Rights. In District of Columbia v. Heller (2008), the Supreme Court affirmed for the first time that this right is not unlimited and does not preclude certain long-standing prohibitions such as those forbidding "the possession of firearms by felons" or "the carrying of dangerous and unusual weapons". A well-regulated Militia is necessary to a free State, so this right shall not be infringed upon by local governments.
