- 1. This bill infringes on our Second Amendment rights by punishing lawful gun owners who possess undetectable firearms or unserialized unfinished frames or receivers.
- 2. The high penalties imposed for possessing or transferring these types of firearms threaten law-abiding citizens with harsh punishments that do not fit their actions.
- 3. Requiring a criminal background check before transferring unfinished frame or receiver is unnecessary and burdensome to responsible gun-owning citizens.
- 4. The vague language used in the bill leaves room for interpretation by prosecutors and may result in unjust convictions of innocent individuals.
- 5. Oregon currently has sufficient laws and regulations to control firearms, so there is no need for additional restrictions that hinder our right to bear arms without reasonable cause.
