Tripling the relocation payment to an existing tenant is excessive. It would make it prohibitive for my aging parents or sister living with a disability to occupy my rental property. We originally purchased a home within a twenty minute walk for my spouse's mother to live out her days and to be her caregivers when that time came. When she passed away, we turned the property into a rental, with the expectation that we would could afford to provide housing for my parents or sister, should they need it in the future, by having them occupy it. This change in law would make that impossible for our family to afford.
