I oppose HB2005 for these reasons:

 (1) This bill infringes on our 2nd Amendment rights by punishing lawful gun owners who possess unmarked firearms or unserialized/unfinished frames or receivers.
(2) The high penalties imposed for possessing or transferring these types of firearms threaten law abiding citizens with harsh punishments that do not fit their actions.
(3) Requiring a criminal background check before transferring an unfinished frame/receiver is unnecessary and burdensome to responsible gun-owning Oregonians.

(4) The vague language used in the bill leaves too much room for interpretation by prosecutors and may result in unjust convictions of innocent individuals.

(5) Oregon has sufficient laws and regulations to control firearms, so there is no need for additional restrictions that hinder our right to bear arms.
