They will give support and emotional help in a catastrophe.

During the fire in 2020, the resources were available but there was no meeting place for people who were losing their homes, children, adults with disabilities and pets. We needed meeting places with the necessary and essential resources during a tragedy.

We need places adapted for people with medical problems or ramps for people who use wheelchairs, resilience centers equipped for all people's needs. If we have the opportunity to be able to take action in time, and implement safe places, before another disaster in Oregon arrives. Now is the time to take action.
