I OPPOSE-

This is against the US Constitution and Oregon Constitution.

US Constitution- The right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

Oregon Constitution-Section 27. Right to bear arms; military subordinate to civil power. The people shall have the right to bear arms for the defence [sic] of themselves, and the State, but the Military shall be kept in strict subordination to the civil power[.]

Definition of infringed and infringement is, “act so as to limit or undermine (something); encroach on.” AND... “the action of limiting or undermining something.”

EXAMPLE BELOW of such a definition: Authorizes governing bodies of certain public entities that own or control public building to adopt policy, ordinance or regulation or precluding affirmative defense for possession of firearms in public building and adjacent grounds by concealed handgun licensees.

As stated in language, “Adopt” policy, ordinance or “regulation”.

ALL examples of INFRINGEMENT to make policy, ordinance, or regulation by adopting as such.
