US Constitution: The right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

Oregon Constitution-Section 27. Right to bear srms; military subordinate to civil power. The people shall have the right to bear arms for the defense [sic] of themselves. and the State, but the Military shall be kept in strict subordination to the civil power [.]

Definition of infringed and infringement is "act so as to limit or undermine (something); encroach on. And..."the action of limiting or undermining something." EXAMPLE relevant to the stated language above from this bill: involves authorization to "adopt policy, ordinance or regulation"....all examples of INFRINGEMENT to make policy, ordinance, or regulation by adopting as such. Also: intention for "precluding " means to prevent from happening or make impossible.
