I am the sole proprietor of Bristol Bay Flies (www.bristolbayflies.com). I am also the leading supplier for fly fishing flies for the Alaskan market. My main supplier of fly-tying materials, Hareline Dubbin, Inc., based in Monroe, OR, supplies me with nearly all my fly tying materials. The rabbit hide strips, bucktails, calf and squirrel tails, etc., that I use for nearly 100% of the flies I supply to the Alaskan market are essential for the survival of my business. HB3390, if passed, would kill my business and only livelihood and it would seriously harm the Alaskan fly fishing market. My clientele come from all over the USA and from around the world. Harline Dubbin, Inc., is the gold-standard in the fly tying industry, and HB3390 would seriously harm that business.

I strongly urge you to exempt the fly-tying industry from HB3390, or seriously re-think the language and/or intent of this incredibly misguided piece of legislation. I cannot emphasize this enough.
