SB 631

I support SB 631; "Permits employees of certain state agencies to refuse to work additional mandatory overtime shift scheduled by employer when employee has already worked mandatory overtime in same month. Prohibits employer from requiring employee to take unpaid leave or use paid time off to make up for refusing to work additional overtime shift, or from taking adverse employment action against employee."

As a correctional officer, I believe the passing of SB 631 would create improvements in the correctional work environment. Limiting mandates would allow correctional officers to have more time with family and friends, be well rested, reduce burn outs, and overall live healthier lives.

When correctional officers are forced to work 16 hour shifts back-to-back, or mandated several times in a week, it reduces the time with family and friends. This can cause an officer to feel unhappy and may cause tension within a household. Overall effecting an officer's level of stress, and motivation.

The mandates cause officers to barely have 8 hours between shifts, leaving them exhausted. They are limited on the time spent on personal care, like eating, socializing, and sleeping. This can create a danger to an officer, as well as adults in custody under their supervision. SB 631 if passed will help reduce burn outs.
