RE: OPPOSE SB 348

Senator Prozanski and Committee Members,

Please oppose SB 348, an unconstitutional bill that makes law-abiding Oregon citizens right to own a gun very difficult. This attempt at "limiting gun violence" does not address the real issue, which is the violent criminals & mentally disturbed individuals behind the guns.

Trying to circumvent the 2nd amendment rights of Oregonians by dropping a 64-page document at 7pm three days before Monday's 5 pm public in-person testimony is unconscionable. This bill does nothing but make measure 114 worse.

Other reasons to oppose SB 348 are:

- *Raising the "permit to purchase" fee from \$65 to \$150 makes it more difficult for people who live in economically challenged areas of the state to purchase a gun.
- *If an 18-year-old can drive, vote, and join the armed forces, they should be allowed to purchase a firearm. They have 2nd amendment rights, as do all Americans.
- *Back-dating the prohibition against magazines holding more than 10 rounds to Dec. 12, 2022, would criminalizes the buyers who bought their magazines legally.

As you can see by the number of written testimonies opposing SB 348 on olis; we the people, do not want this infringement on our 2nd amendment rights to pass. This bill is full of bureaucratic red tape and tries to circumvents the Constitutional and our courts of law.
