I also know 2 senior citizens who had to move due to increases in rent when a private equity company purchased their apartment building, where they hoped to live until their death. That company added fees for "outdoor lightening" and some other previously un-itemized charges, in addition to increasing the monthly rent- beyond what these two women could pay. Because they had help from family, they each were able to move to smaller and lower-rent apartment. I have no idea whether some of their neighbors became homeless.

We all acknowledge there is a housing crisis in our state due to high rents and fewer family wage jobs compared to years ago. Please vote SB 611 out of committee.
