I write to you today in support of SB 611 which will create effective policy for tenant-landowner affairs, taking into consideration the ongoing housing crisis affecting Oregonians state-wide.

SB 611 will seek to limit annual rent increases and also increase the amount that a landowner owes a tenant in cases of wrongful termination of tenancy. Providing this protection for renters during these trying times will ensure that the livelihoods of countless families in the state are recognized and protected.

At our agency we support implementing proper rental policy for our underserved and underprivileged community. In 2023 Oregonians are facing up to a 14.6% increase in rent, we must recognize that examples such as these furthers accessibility of housing and is displacing individuals and families all across the state of Oregon. I hope that the committee will take a stand for those living paycheck to paycheck trying to get by and working to provide a safe haven for their family. To support this bill will mean to take action and prevent displacement for many individuals in our state.
