I oppose the proposed legislation as presently written because it would restrict the sale of fly tying materials and fishing flies. I often purchase materials and flies from fly fishing shops in Oregon because there are many more such businesses there than in Washington State. Enactment of a law prohibiting the sale of fur products would adversely impact the many fly fishing shops and suppliers that now contribute to Oregon's economy, possibly leading to closure of some of them.

I note that there is an exemption for leather goods and taxidermy uses in the proposed legislation. There should also be an exemption for items that are used for fly tying and fly fishing.
