Dear Chair Prozanski and fellow Judiciary Committee Senators,

I submit this testimony in **ABSOLUTE OPPOSITION of SB348**. First, this 'gut and stuff' tactic to 'amend' bills by those hellbent on violating the constitutional rights of The People, must be stopped!
