## RE: SB 348 AS AMENDED BY THE -1 AMENDMENT

Dear Chair Prozanski & Members of the Senate Committee on Judiciary,

## I strongly oppose SB 348-1.

Each of you took the following oath of office as set out in Article IV, Section 31 of the Oregon Constitution: "I do solemnly swear (or affirm as the case may be) that I will support the Constitution of the United States, and the Constitution of the State of Oregon, and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of Senator (or Representative as the case may be) according to the best of my Ability."

The second Amendment of the US Constitution provides "the right of the people to keep and bear Arms shall not be infringed." Article I, Section 27 of the Oregon Constitution provides, that "The people shall have the right to bear arms for the defence [sic] of themselves."

Senate Bill 348-1 is a direct infringement of the natural right of Oregonians to bear arms to defend themselves, and a vote in favor of the bill would be a direct violation of your oath of office.

Defending and championing both Constitutions as you are required to do and voting in favor of SB 348-1 are mutually exclusive. The two are completely incompatible. I urge each of you to adhere to the oaths of office you swore to and to **vote no on SB 348-1**.
