Housing Authorities of Oregon support HB 3417

To: Chair Dexter, Vice-Chair Gamba, Vice-Chair Helfrich and
Members of the House Committee on Housing and
Homelessness:

The Housing Authorities of Oregon are, collectively, the largest providers of affordable housing in the state of Oregon. There are 22 Housing Authorities that serve all 36 counties. Our goal is to provide a safe, affordable place for Oregonians with low incomes to call home.

The Housing Authorities of Oregon supports HB 3417. This bill will expand the use of a successful program that protects landlords and expands housing opportunities for low-income tenants.

While we have learned that low-income tenants do not damage units at greater rates than other tenants, if damages do occur, it can be harder for landlords to be made whole if a tenant cannot afford to pay for those damages. HB 3417 addresses this problem by providing access to funds to mitigate damages.

The Housing Authorities were part of the original agreement that created the successful Landlord Guarantee Fund and are pleased to support this effort to expand it.
