## YES ON HB3113 'GREAT STREETS'









ODOT's "**Great Streets**" program is a worthwhile investment for Oregon at a critical time. People are paying with their lives for our failure to provide safe streets for residents. According to NHTSA data, Oregon had the 10<sup>th</sup> highest traffic fatality rate in the country in the last half of 2022. Pedestrian fatalities in Oregon were up 61% percent over the previous year in that time period and these conditions disproportionately affect BIPOC and low-income Oregonians.

With an additional \$100M in funding for Great Streets, we can reduce the number of serious injuries and deaths on our roads while strategically investing in vibrant, safe, and sustainable communities across Oregon.

- Safety Improvements: Safety is a priority in ODOT's Strategic Action Plan (SAP) and Great Streets funding supports catalytic improvements on our most dangerous roads. By prioritizing the safety of all users, including people walking, biking, and driving, investments in Great Streets can help reduce the number of accidents and injuries on our roads. This means fewer emergency room visits and lower medical expenses, which can save money in the long run.
- **Economic Benefits:** By revitalizing streets and creating more walkable and bikeable communities, businesses can see an increase in foot traffic and revenue. This economic boost can result in increased tax revenue for the state and the creation of new jobs.
- **Public Health:** Creating more walkable and bikeable communities can reduce deaths and have a positive impact on public health. By providing more opportunities for physical activity, Great Streets help combat the rising rates of obesity and related health problems. This can lead to lower healthcare costs and a healthier population, benefitting the state in many ways.
- Climate Change: This program helps reduce greenhouse gas emissions and combat climate change. By encouraging more people to walk, bike, and take public transit, Great Streets can help reduce the number of cars on the road (reduce VMT) and the amount of carbon (GHG) emissions they produce.
- Environmental Justice and Equity: Great Streets promote equity by improving access to transportation for underserved communities. 27% of Oregonians do not have a driver's license. More walkable and bikeable streets help reduce transportation costs for low-income households and provide more options for low-income people who may not own a car. This can help reduce transportation-related barriers to education, employment, and other opportunities while improving air quality and other health factors in neighborhoods.
