The climate/weather eventually stabilized, but generations of people were impoverished. My family like others began a pattern of migration to Oregon and Washington for work and mild/predictable weather.

Because of this cultural memory, the unpredictable and extreme weather of these times scares me. It's not going to get back to normal in a short period of time like it did then. We must get to work now making our farms, ranches, forests, oceans and air and water resources more resilient to climate impacts. The same goes for our communities. Furthermore, we need to use every tool we can including our natural and working lands to mitigate the causes of climate change and ensure ourselves and children a livable would.

Once again, please provide the funding to implement this important legislation.
