Our budget must reflect the reality of our climate emergency. Please fully fund all agency budgets for the implementation of former Governor Brown's Climate Action Plan (aka Executive Order 20-04). Further, make sure that any and all subsidies for fossil fuel operations, industrial timber and industrial agriculture are eliminated from the budget.

The budget must also address building emissions and health by funding the building resilience package. The Healthy Heating and Cooling for All bill (SB 868) is particularly vital at this time to electrify homes and develop our workforce for a clean building future.
