I'm writing to raise attention to the SB91, which will help our states most vulnerable disabled children. We need to properly fund this important bill.

- 1. raise the \$3 million cap! Without a larger budget, this program will help very few children, regardless of the eligibility described in the bill.
- 2. add the ability to use the funds from other programs that would have been spent on these children and families, such as K plan, to fund SB91. This also includes the savings Oregon will see with healthier and more financially stable families who are less reliant on other forms of assistance.

I understand that Ways and Means is also considering HB 2457, which would tie DSP wages to 150 percent of minimum wage. The fiscal analysis states that it will cost \$325 million general fund (\$921 million total fund). These bills are trying to help similar populations. Can you tie the funding together for SB91, as it should be?
