I write to oppose SB 27. Until the wording says, "AUDIT the voter rolls and remove people who have moved, who have died, who are not citizens, or receive ballots at two addresses (as, students), the public will continue to be disenfranchised. The public waning confidence in how the Secretary of State maintains the voting list on a major reason for diminished voter participation. Do not bother passing this bill. It is disingenuous.
