Dear Senator Frederick and Representative McLain:

As the Coordinator of the Lower Rogue Watershed Council, I am writing to express my support for two important statewide, public service programs at Portland State University: 1) **Oregon Consensus**, a program of the state's dispute resolution services, and 2) **Oregon Solutions**, the state's program for collaborative implementation of community-based solutions. I have experienced first-hand the benefit these programs provide throughout all parts of our state in helping to support community-based problem solving. I am thankful the legislature recognizes the significance of these programs and urge you to restore their funding to the full continuing level of service (CSL) as in the Governor's budget.

Last year, we worked closely with the staff at Oregon Consensus (OC) through the work outlined in HB5006 (2021) to create a State-Supported Regional Water Planning and Management Work. We worked to develop a framework and path for state-supported water planning and management at the water region and/or basin level, considering regional water management opportunities that build on the 100-Year Water Vision and further the goals of the Integrated Water Resources Strategy. The OC staff were a pleasure to work with and provided multiple opportunities and intentional spaces for engagement and input throughout that entire process, in addition to connection within the work group. They lead with integrity, transparency, and accountability.

Oregon Solutions and Oregon Consensus programs provide very distinct and critical services to communities across the State in implementing sustainable solutions and cost effective resolutions to contentious issues. I am thankful the legislature recognizes the significance of these programs, and hope they will continue to be supported.
