Non-animal testing produces results that translate better to humans. Thalidomide is an example of a drug that appeared to be safe when tested on rabbits and other animals but had terrible results when used on humans.

More than 30 countries and 10 states, including California and Nevada, have already banned the sale of cosmetics newly tested on animals, and Oregon should too.
