My name is Chelsea Davis and I am an Oregon resident, small business owner, and co-founder of Animal Rights Collective Portland (ARCPDX). Thank you for this opportunity to express my support for HB 3213 which would prohibit the sale of cosmetics tested on animals in Oregon. Animal testing is cruel and unnecessary. Animals typically used in testing for cosmetic ingredients and products are not covered by the animal welfare act and the pain they are forced to endure is horrific. Animal testing is also outdated and ineffective.

Successful alternatives to animal testing already exist as proven by the countless cosmetic companies (including very cost-effective companies like Elf, Wet & Wild, and Cover Girl) that refuse to test on animals.
