RE: Letter of Support—SB643

Dear House Committee on Economic Development and Small Business,

The City of Bend is supportive of SB643 and your work aid cottage food producers. In Bend, commercial kitchen space remains at a premium and the high cost of housing has left many residents seeking to start or grow a business from the home. We have local requirements in place to ensure home-based businesses operate in a manner that aligns with neighborhood expectations.

We understand the concerns raised around public health and believe these can be addressed in coordination with local regulatory agencies. Allowing cottage food producers to expand their market while adhering to clear labeling, inspection requirements, and limiting allowable products to those generally considered shelf-stable are measures that have proved successful in other states.

Further, formalizing and modernizing these requirements will help at-home food producers, who may have been operating out of the view of regulatory agencies, bring their operation into compliance, allowing for regular inspections of kitchens and at-home food processing facilities.

Again, we appreciate your efforts to help foster economic growth that will benefit all residents of Bend and the State of Oregon.
