I support the -3 Amendment (and the policy recommendations offered by the Just Crossing Alliance) that ensures this replacement bridge project moves forward smoothly with a right-sized design, explicit pro-labor provisions, financial guardrails, and major investments in mass transit.

We need to act in accordance with the basic principles of induced demand, and not spend billions of dollars to learn that adding lanes to freeways only leads to more traffic jams.
