Chair Kropf, Vice-Chairs Andersen and Wallan, and Members of the Committee:

My name is Kaiti Ferguson, Senior Staff Counsel at the Oregon Judicial Department (OJD). OJD is neutral on SB 326 A-Engrossed, but I am submitting this testimony to thank Representative Morgan and Senator Prozanski for their leadership and including OJD in the discussions on this concept over the past several months.
