My name is Amii Chong. I am the Executive Director of St. Johns Center for Opportunity in North Portland. We own and operate the St. Johns Farmers Market. I am writing to request your support for **HB 2728.**

HB 2728 supports the expansion of Double Up Food Bucks Oregon, a SNAP incentive program with a proven record of success. For every dollar spent on SNAP-eligible foods at participating farmers markets, farm share programs, and grocery stores across the state, shoppers will receive a dollar to spend on Oregon-grown fruits and vegetables.

By offering DUFB at St. Johns Farmers Market, we are able to help folks feed their families nutritious local produce while also bolstering our local farmers.

Thanks to the increased state funding for Double Up Food Bucks in 2021, our Farmers Market was able to significantly expand our DUFB program and support many more families. We sincerely thank you for that, and hope that you will continue to support this amazing program that touches the lives of so many low-income families.
