- An Interstate Bridge with seismic upgrades and options for biking, walking and public transit, rather than a several lane expansion that will consume the lion's share of our state's transportation budget.
- A phased funding plan that ensures accountability every step of the way.
- A transportation package that won't expand the I-5 freeway through the Rose Quarter, which would only increase pollution in Portland's historically Black neighborhood.
