Demographics: Both Tillamook and Lincoln Counties have a severe

shortage of Preschool options for working families. According to *Oregon's Child Care Deserts (Oregon State University, 2019)*, **Both Tillamook and Lincoln County are childcare deserts**, where 66% of children do not have access to licensed childcare and early education options. The study found Lincoln County supported only 27% and Tillamook County

21% of the total need.

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Accessibility:

Economic

Neskowin Valley School has a long history of providing affordable education alternatives for families of all economic backgrounds, providing scholarships for families based on need.

Race and Ethnicity

The existing student population is racially and ethnically diverse (28% BIPOC) beyond the baseline population of both Counties (10% BIPOC).

Disability

The new facility is designed to create a welcoming environment where children with disabilities can thrive, meeting or exceeding ADA standards.

Funding Status:

The NVS capital campaign is on track to raise the \$1 million 50% match to complete funding. Discussions are in progress with lead donors.
