I am not a motorcyclist, but based on the merits of multiple studies regarding lane splitting, I support SB422 for the following reasons:

- 1. The risk of motorcyclists getting ready ended at traffic lights is greatly reduced
- 2. Lane splitting improves the flow of traffic for all road users
