The importance of the Preservation Movement was underscored this past March by the Pritzker Prize in Architecture winner, Sir David Chipperfield, who said in his acceptance speech that "the future of architecture will be increasingly in the re-design & re-use of older buildings & historic rehabilitation, because of the space limitations in cities, & the financial benefits in adaptive re-use of pre-existing structures."

HB3414 deserves further research & collaboration with preservation organizations, like Restore Oregon & others, to include wider consideration of present & future trends in city planning & adaptive re-use of existing buildings & houses, the preservation of historic structures of all types, & the economic factors in the general population.
