I have been riding motorcycles since 1972, and I am in complete and total favor of letting motorcyclists get out of the way of other traffic in periods of slower heavily congested and/or stop/go traffic flow by cautiously rolling between lanes past all other stopped and slowed vehicles and safely resuming within a normal lane as when clear to do so. I would also favor penalties for abuse in passing slower vehicles too fast or in an unsafe manner, or when current traffic flow conditions are not truly applicable to allow such, while periods of extreme-heat weather conditions should perhaps include a bit of lenience as air-cooled engines need airflow to cool. Plus I would very strongly favor fully adequate and suitable penalties please be included for any vehicle driver that may intentionally try to obstruct or block the path of a rider's passing or by any means purposely intending to cause collision and/or injury to a rider and including passenger if applicable.
