- 1. I fully support the points expressed in the letter supporting appointment to the commission by river basin presented to the Rules Committee by the Coalition of Stakeholders that includes the Oregon Cattlemen's Association.
- 2. The River basin model for appointments is a common-sense approach. The approach is more representative of Oregon's diversity of people, fish and wildlife and the habitat needed to support them.
