Public Hearing

SB 965

Allows Oregon Health Authority to conduct off-site investigation after receiving certain complaints against hospitals.

SB 968

Requires Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with System of Care Advisory Council, to study Oregon's systems of care.

SB 967

Allows Oregon Health Authority to reimburse coordinated care organizations using payment mechanisms other than global budgets under specified circumstances.

SB 966

Requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt standards for types of data collected for all payer, all claims database that are consistent with standards adopted for collection of data on race, ethnicity, language, disability status, sexual orientation and gender identity.

SB 973 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Oregon Health Authority to maintain state public health laboratory, administer newborn bloodspot screening program and implement educational program for newborn bloodspot screening program.
