SB 987

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Requires Public Employees Retirement Board to study approaches to lowering employer contribution rate paid by charter schools under Public Employees Retirement System.

SB 1048 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Directs Department of Transportation to establish small business assistance program to assist qualified small businesses in competing for department's public improvement contracts.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 631

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Permits employees of certain state agencies to refuse to work additional mandatory overtime shift scheduled by employer when employee has already worked mandatory overtime in same month.

#### Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 851

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Requires Bureau of Labor and Industries to study matters relating to psychological abuse occurring in workplaces in Oregon.

SB 907

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Provides employee with right to refuse to perform task assigned by employer under certain circumstances.

SB 925

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Makes unlawful practice for employer or employment agency to advertise job, promotion or transfer opportunity without disclosing pay range and employment benefits in job posting.

SB 999

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/28/2023 MEETING: Requires Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issues relating to different leave laws under which individuals may take time off of work for qualifying reasons.
