

SB 1071 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Increases the maximum loading weight of a boat allowed to obtain a towed watersports endorsement from 5,500 to 7,500 pounds. Specifies that the motorboat maximum loading weight means the factory-specified dry gross weight of a motorboat. Modifies the definition of the "Newberg Pool Congested Zone." Declares emergency, effective on passage.
