Measure Description:

Prohibits distributing, selling, attempting to sell or allowing to be sold flavored inhalant delivery system product or flavored tobacco product in this state.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of State Police, Department of Justice, Oregon Health Authority, Department of Revenue, Judicial Department

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure makes distribution, selling or attempt to sell a flavored inhalant delivery system product or flavored tobacco product illegal in Oregon subject to the exceptions listed in the measure. The measure declares an emergency and is effective on passage.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
