Subject: SB 619 - Relating to protections for the personal data of consumers

Work Session Recommendations

The measure provides specific rights and regulations to consumers personal data that provide products or services to residents of the state. The measure is effective on January 1, 2024, however, provisions of the measure have delayed operative dates of either July 1, 2024, July 1, 2025, or January 1, 2026.

A staff measure summary, fiscal impact statement, and revenue impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS) and a budget report will be prepared for the measure. There is one policy amendment and one budget amendment to the measure.
