**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2652**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, line 25, after “Act” insert “, or the Behav-
2 ioral Health Incentive Subaccount created under ORS 675.653,”.

3 Deletes lines 43 through 45 and on page 3 delete lines 1 through 16 and
4 insert:

5 “(A) Bonuses and stipends for supervisors of interns or associates.

6 “(B) Child care and elder care subsidies.

7 “(C) Housing assistance.

8 “(D) Licensure examination preparation.

9 “(E) Loan forgiveness and repayment incentives.

10 “(F) Part-time and flextime opportunities.

11 “(G) Physical, mental and behavioral health assistance.

12 “(H) Professional development.

13 “(I) Retention bonuses.

14 “(J) Safety needs.

15 “(K) Scholarships for undergraduate and graduate students studying for
16 entry into the fields of health care and human services.

17 “(L) Signing bonuses.

18 “(M) Stipends for graduate students enrolled in health care and human
19 services programs.

20 “(N) Subsidized dual certification with a focus on rural and vulnerable
21 populations and pay equity.

1 “(O) Telehealth infrastructure subsidies, including, but not limited to,
2 broadband service.

3 “(P) Tuition assistance and reimbursement.”.

4 Delete lines 22 through 40 and insert:

5 “(A) Audiologists, speech-language pathologists, music therapists and art
6 therapists.

7 “(B) Caregivers.

8 “(C) Case managers.

9 “(D) Case workers.

10 “(E) Certified nurses assistants.

11 “(F) Chiropractors.

12 “(G) Community support specialists.

13 “(H) Counselors.

14 “(I) Dental assistants.

15 “(J) Dental hygienists.

16 “(K) Dentists.

17 “(L) Dietitians.

18 “(M) Direct care workers.

19 “(N) Direct service workers.

20 “(O) Doctors.

21 “(P) Emergency medical services providers.

22 “(Q) Environmental health specialists.

23 “(R) General human services workers.

24 “(S) Gerontologists.

25 “(T) Homecare workers.

26 “(U) Home health aides.

27 “(V) Homeless services workers.

28 “(W) Massage therapists.

2 “(AA) Nurses.

8 “(GG) Physician assistants.
9 “(HH) Program managers and coordinators of health care and human
10 services programs.
11 “(II) Psychologists.
12 “(JJ) Qualified mental health providers.
13 “(KK) Social workers.
14 “(LL) Traditional health workers.
15 “(MM) Veterinarians and veterinary technicians.”.
16 On page 4, delete lines 3 through 10 and insert:
17 “(A) Animal services.
18 “(B) Child care.
19 “(C) Disability and aging services.
20 “(D) Emergency management.
21 “(E) Health care and human services administration.
22 “(F) Intellectual and developmental disabilities services.
23 “(G) Physical, mental, behavioral and nutritional health.
24 “(H) Solid waste and recycling.
25 “(I) Veterans services.”.
26 After line 41, insert:
27 “(6)(a) The governing body of a county whose application has been ap-
28 proved under section 1 (4) of this 2023 Act may request the authority to make
29 funds available to the county as an employer for the purposes of this section.
30 “(b) The application process prescribed by the authority under subsection

1 (3) of this section does not apply to a county as an employer.

2 “(c) A county that receives funds under this subsection shall be consid-
3 ered an employer for purposes of section 3 of this 2023 Act.”.

4 On page 6, line 12, before the period insert “throughout their lifespans”.

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
